

ORDINANCE No. 60-4481

ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING ONE THOUSAND PESOS FOR THE EXPENSES TO BE INCURRED IN THE CELEBRATION OF QUEZON DAY ON AUGUST 19, 1960, THE AMOUNT TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUND IN THE CITY TREASURY.

Introduced by Councillor Sebastian

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the city treasury, the sum of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to cover expenses in the celebration of Quezon Day on August 19, 1960, including expenses to be incurred for the laying of the Marker of the proposed City Hall Building at the Civic Center site.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval.
