

ORDINANCE No. 60-1498

ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS TO COVER THE CLAIM OF THE HEIRS OF THE LATE DETECTIVE JOSE G. CRUZ OF THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 699, AS AMENDED, OF THE REVISED ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE AUTHORITIES CONCERNED.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. There is hereby set aside from any available funds in the city treasury, the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (P1,250.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to cover the claim of the heirs of the late Jose G. Cruz of the Quezon City Police Department, who died in line of duty within the purview of Section 699, as amended, of the Revised Administrative Code, subject to the approval of the authorities concerned.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
