ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING FIVE HUNDRED PESOS FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUND IN THE CITY TREASURY TO DEFRAY THE COST OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WOODEN FOOT BRIDGE CROSSING THE CREEK BETWEEN FIRST AVENUE AND THE BACKYARD OF THE BERNARDO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN CUBAO, QUEZON CITY.


Introduced by Councillor Sebastian

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City
in session assembled:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available fund in the city treasury, the sum of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) to defray the cost of the construction of a wooden foot bridge crossing the creek between First Avenue and the backyard of the Bernardo Elementary School in Cubao, this City, the old one having been washed away by the flood last June.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
