CREATING THE POSITIONS OF SEVENTY TEMPORARY PATROLMEN IN THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SIXTY FIVE THOUSAND PESOS FOR THEIR SALARIES AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF PISTOLS, RAINCOATS, AND FLASHLIGHTS. FROM ANY UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.

Section 1. The positions of seventy (70) Temporary Patrolmen with salary at the rate of One Hundred Twenty Pesos (P120.00) each per month is hereby created in the Quezon City Police Department, for the use of said

Sec. 2. For purposes of this Ordinance, the sum of Sixty-five Thousand Pesos (P65,000.00) is hereby appropriated from any unappropriated funds in the City Treasury to cover salaries for six months of the seventy temporary Patrolmen, and for the purchase of 70 pistols, 70 raincoats, and 70 flashlights.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval.
