APPROPRIATING THREE HUNDRED PESOS TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN THE TRANSFER OF THE SIREN PRESENTLY INSTALLED ATOP THE LEFT WING OF THE CITY HALL BUILDING TO SOME OTHER PLACE.
