PROHIBITING THE MANUFACTURE, SALE, POSSESSION AND/OR
FIRING, LIGHTING OR EXPLODING OF FIRECRACKERS, SKYROCKETS,
FIREWORKS AND TOYS MADE OF EMPTY CARTRIDGES (SHELL) AND
PISTON (NAILS) FED WITH EXPLOSIVE POWDER, AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Introduced by Councilor Albert

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in
session assembled:

Section 1. Prohibition. It shall be unlawful for
any person to manufacture or cause to be manufactured,
sell or cause to be sold, possess and/or light, fire or
explode, firecrackers, or toys made of empty cartridges
(shell) skyrockets or any kind or class of fireworks, or
toys made of empty cartridges (shell) and piston (nails)
fed with explosive powder.

Sec. 2. Penalty.- Any violation of the provisions
of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not ex-
ceeding Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) or by imprisonment
of not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and
imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

If the violation is committed by a corporation, partner-
ship, or any juridical entity, the Manager, or the managing
partner or any person charged with the management thereof
shall be held liable under this Ordinance.

Sec. 3. Repealing Clause. All Ordinances and Resolu-
tions or parts thereof inconsistent hereof are hereby re-
pealed.

Sec. 4. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect
upon its approval.
