ORDINANCE NO. SP-**2590**, S-2017

AN ORDINANCE ACCREDITING THE TWO HUNDRED FORTY (240) NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs) AND PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS (POs) PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, AND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS, IN RELATION TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2016-97 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG).

WHEREAS, Section 34 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", provides that local government units shall promote the establishment and operations of non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and people's organizations (POs) to become partners in the pursuit of local economy; ¶

WHEREAS, Article 64 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the said Code provides that the local sanggunian concerned shall accredit the NGOs and POs based within its jurisdiction subject to the criteria and procedures for membership set-forth by the local special bodies;

WHEREAS, relative to the said Code and its IRR, Ordinance No. SP-23, S-92 was enacted creating the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee to process the applications for accreditation of NGOs and POs;

WHEREAS, these Two Hundred Forty (240) NGOs and POs applied for accreditation with the Quezon City Council, through the Community Relations Office (CRO);

WHEREAS, the said applications were processed and evaluated by the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee and favorably recommended to the Quezon City Council for accreditation.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY  
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby accredited the Two Hundred Forty (240) Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) and People's Organizations (POs) pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), in relation to DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2016-97.

SECTION 2. The herein accredited organizations shall inform, within thirty (30) days, the Quezon City Council, through the Office of the City Secretary, copy furnished the Community Relations Office (CRO), of any major changes in their organizations, particularly with respect to their officers and office addresses.

SECTION 3. The Quezon City Government, through the Office of the City Secretary and in coordination with the CRO, shall prepare and issue Certificates of Accreditation to the herein accredited organizations, duly signed by the City Mayor, the City Vice Mayor and the Chairman of the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee and attested by the City Secretary. ✓




SECTION 4. The official list of the said Two Hundred Forty (240) organizations is hereby made an integral part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




