ORDINANCE

RESERVING AND ALLOTING THE NORTHWEST-SOUTHWEST QUADRANT OF THE BERNARDO PARK, QUEZON CITY, BORDERING EPIFANIO DE LOS SANTOS AVENUE AND K-F STREET ALONG THE NORTHWEST AXIS, AND BORDERING THE QUEZON CITY GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL, QCPD BASKETBALL COURT, AND QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT ALONG THE SOUTHWEST AXIS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND ESTABLISHMENT THEREON OF A YOUTH CENTER BUILDING TO BE SPONSORED BY THE JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE OF QUEZON CITY (CAPITOL JAYCEES).

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. The Northwest-Southwest quadrant of the Bernardo Park, Quezon City, bordering Epifanio de los Santos Avenue on the Northeast axis and bounded on the Southwest by K-F Street and on the Northwest by the Quezon City Girl Scout Council lot, QCPD basketball Court and the Quezon City Police Department main building, is hereby reserved and allotted as site for a Youth Center to be put up by the Capitol Jaycees otherwise known as the Junior Chamber of Commerce of Quezon City who shall construct thereon at its expense, the building or buildings needed for the project.

Sec. 2. The Capitol Jaycees as sponsors of the Youth Center project, shall have a free hand in the planning, supervision, and construction of the building or buildings in consultation with the City authorities concerned, and shall be exempt from the payment of the corresponding taxes, licenses, and fees provided for under existing Ordinances on building construction.


Sec. 3. The Capitol Jaycees shall turn over each building of the Youth Center upon completion to the City government for appropriate maintenance and administration by the latter.

Sec. 4. The building or buildings which shall be used mainly as youth center, shall be named "Capitol Jaycee Youth Center" which name shall be permanently and properly inscribed on the facade fronting Epifanio de los Santos Avenue.


Sec. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval.


