ORDINANCE CREATING THE BARRIO OF KALIGAYAHAN IN QUEZON CITY, AND DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF.

Introduced by the Committee on Barrio Government

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. There is hereby created a barrio at
Novaliches, Quezon City, to be known as "Bartio Kaligayahan", comprising four sitios (Serrano, Miranda, Binugsok and Zabarte) with boundaries defined as fellows:

NORTH AND NORTHWEST: -- Quezon City Boundary line with Caloccan, Province of Rizal (Now Caloccan City);

- EAST: -- Nolasco road and the Eastern pendary lines of Lots 897 and 1113 of the Tala Estate;
- SOUTH: -- Southern boundary line of Lots 1113, 881-A, 301, 300, 192 and 187; and Western boundary line of Lots 301, 305, 306, and 307; and the Eastern boundary line of Lot 189, all of the Tala Estate;
- WEST: -- The Western boundary line of Lots 487, 193, 490, 802, 382, 384, 876, 869 and South Western boundary line of Lot 1035, all of the Tala Estate.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
