

WHEREAS, Section 167 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "all local taxes, fees and charges shall be paid within the first twenty (20) days of January or of each subsequent quarter, as the case may be. The Sanggunian concerned may, for a justifiable reason or cause, extend the time for payment of such taxes, fees, or charges without surcharges or penalties, but only for a period not exceeding six (6) months";

WHEREAS, \*considering the large number of taxpayers who will converge to the Quezon City Hall Compound and the limitation of the existing human resource of the City Treasurer's Office, there is an imperative need to extend the deadline for the payment of Business Taxes for the current year;

WHEREAS, in the interest of the above-described symbiotic relationship between the Local Government of Quezon City and taxpayers, the deadline for payment of business tax should be extended at least fifteen (15) days to accommodate tax payments without penalties, surcharges or interests.





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## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. COVERAGE – All Annual and Quarterly Business Taxes and Fees due and payable to the Quezon City Government for the current year which is due to be paid on or before January 20, 2018 can be paid not later than February 04, 2018 without penalties, surcharge or interests.

SECTION 2. PENALTIES AND INTEREST – All Business Taxes and Fees due for the current period shall, however, be subject to the penalties and interests prescribed by the Quezon City Revenue Code, as amended, if not paid on or before February 04, 2018.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE - Any provisions of ordinances, executive orders, issuances or rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its Approval.
