AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE NECESSARY EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF QUEZON CITY DURING THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1 TO JUNE 30, 1947, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

Be it ordained by the City Council of Queson City that:

SECTION 1. The sum of two hundred eighty-seven thousand two
bundred thirty four pesos (P287,234.00) or so much thereof as may
be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in
the City Treasury not etherwise appropriated to meet the expenses
of the Government of Queson City during the period from January 1,
1947 to June 30, 1947, the details of which are contained in Provincial Form No. 28(A), herewith attached and made part of this

Ordinance.

solely for the specific purposes for which apprepriated and for no other; Provided, That the City Treasurer, upon the approval of the Mayor, shall, before June thirtieth, nineteen hundred forty-seven, effect in the account books of the City Treasurer such transfer or readjustment of unexpected balances from one item to another in the appropriation of all offices of the city government during the period from January first, nineteen hundred forty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred forty-seven, as would offset whatever deficiency appearing at the close of said period in the figures therein as to other items of each office appropriation.

SEC. 3. No position herein ereated or any vacancy that may occur hereafter shall be filled without the prior approval of the City Mayor.

SEC. 4. No efficer or employee of any branch of the city government other than those specifically authorized herein shall be paid any allowance directly or indirectly for the use of his own automobile on efficial business payable from any appropriation set aside in this Ordinance unless specifically authorized by the City Council; Provided, however, That employee of any branch of the National Government or of

any provincial government who may be detailed to render service for the benefit of the Government of Queson City shall be entitled to the same rates of per diems in lieu of subsistence while engaged in such service, as well as automobile allowances as are allowed to them in their regular positions.

SEC. 5. All purchases of furniture and equipment the cost of which is payable from the appropriations herein authorized shall be made with the previous approval of the City Mayor.

SEC. 6. No appropriation authorised in this Ordinance shall be available directly or indirectly for the purchase of any automobile, auto jitney or station wagen unless specifically authorised herein.

SEC. 7. Any unexpended balance of all appropriations made on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred forty-seven, shall revert to the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the city treasury.

SEC. 8. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1st, 1947. Unanimously approved, January 11, 1947.
