ORDINANCE Numbered 8

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING REGULATORY FEES TO OWNERS OR OPERATORS OF QUARRIES IN QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City that:

SECTION 1. No person, association, corporation or partnership shall be allowed to quarry, take or gather adobe stones for commercial purpose within the jurisdiction of Quezon City unless the said person, corporation or partnership shall have applied for a permit therefor from the City Mayor and paid to the City Treasurer the following fees:

For the first ten cubic meters - ₱1.00
For each cubic meter in excess of the first ten - ₱.10
PROVIDED that the minimum fee to be collected under this ordinance shall be ₱5.00


SEC. 2. Any violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than ₱200.00 or by imprisonment, not exceeding two months, or both such fine or imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. If the violation is committed by an association, corporation or partnership, the manager, the managing director or the person charged with the management of the business of such association, corporation or partnership shall be criminally responsible therefor.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


