ORDINANCE Numbered 10

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO REGULATE THE USE OF CERTAIN STREETS BY VEHICLES IN KAMUNING, QUEZON CITY, AND TO PROVIDE PUNISH-MENT FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, by virtue of Section 12 (e) of Commonwealth Act No. 502, the City Council is empowered to regulate the use of streets and public places by vehicles in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Councilor Leon C. Malubay, has invited the attention of the City Council to the necessity of prohibiting the passing of vehicles in front of the Kamuning Elementary School in the interest of the public safety especially of the school children;

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council that:

SECTION 1. To authorize the City Mayor to regulate vehicular traffic by prohibiting the passing of vehicles in front of the Kamuning Elementary School (on K-C Street) from the corner of K-2nd Street to K-3rd Street between 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. during school days and to cause "CLOSE TO TRAFFIC from 7:00 M.M. to 5:00 P. M. on school days" signs to be posted therein for that purpose. It is provided further that unnecessary noise, shouting or tooting of the horns to avoid the disturbances of school classes, be prohibited.

SEC. 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred pesos (Pl00.00) or by imprisonment of not more than two (2) months or by both in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
