ORDINANCE Numbered 11

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING ONE OF THE TWO SPECIAL AGENT POSITIONS IN THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR (ITEM 6, PLANTILLA OF PERSONNEL, CURRENT SERIES) AND CREATING A POSITION OF A PRIVATE SECRETARY TO THE MAYOR AND FIXING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE SAME.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

SECTION 1. One of the positions of Special Agent under the office of the Mayor (contained in the Plantilla of Personnel, current series) with a basic pay of P720.00 per annum is hereby abolished. In lieu thereof, a position of Private Secretary to the City Mayor with an annual basic salary of P2,400.00 is created.

SEC. 2. The duties of this new office is to handle private correspondence of the City Mayor and such other function as the Mayor may see fit to assign to the incumbent from time to time.

SEC. 3. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to set aside so much of the amount that may be necessary for the salary, bonuses and insurance premiums allotted to this position from March 4, 1947 to June 30, 1947.

SEC. 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
