ORDINANCE Numbered 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ITEM No. 13 (PLANTILLA), PAGE 2, UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY HEALTH OFFICER, ORDINANCE NO. 1, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the present City Health Officer is actually receiving a salary of P3,120.00 per annum which salary is admittedly inadequate considering the present standard of living and his social standing as official of the City Government;

WHEREAS, it is true that this was the rate of compensation provided for the said position before the war;

WHEREAS, it is an acknowledged fact that even before the war, when the cost of living was normal, this amount was deemed inadequate for the salary of the aforementioned official;

WHEREAS, the current inflation has depreciated the purchasing value of the peso to unprecedented level, a fact that would justify an increase in the present salary of this official;

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

SECTION 1. Item No. 13 (Plantilla), page 2, under the office of the City Health Officer, Ordinance No. 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

✓ "13. One City Health Officer at P3,600.00 per annum".

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect as of March 5, 1947.

SEC. 3. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to set aside so much of the amount that may be necessary for the increase of the salary allotted to this item from March 5, 1947 to June 30, 1947, out of the unappropriated funds of Quezon City.

Unanimously passed, March 17, 1947.
