requesting the Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact an ordinance
renaming the portion of Bukidnon Street to Sto. Nino Street in Bago
Bantay, Barangay Ramon Magsaysay, District-1, Quezon City;*

*WHEREAS, Sto. Niño Parish Shrine has been in existence
from 1967 up to the present and will be celebrating its 50th Golden
Year Anniversary this year, 2017;*

WHEREAS, Sto. Niño Parish Shrine has given its share in the history and touched countless lives of people in the area;

WHEREAS, the renaming of said street shall make the identification of the church's location in the area easy and accurate;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Quezon City is authorized to change the name of streets within its territorial jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. The portion of Bukidnon Street, Barangay Ramon Magsaysay, Quezon City, commencing from the corner of Corregidor Street to Nueva Ecija Street, is hereby renamed to Sto. Niño Street.

SECTION 2. The City Engineer's Office and the City General Services Department are hereby mandated to install the street signs with the corresponding name in every conspicuous corner.


SECTION 3. The City Secretary is hereby directed, upon the approval and effectivity of this Ordinance, to furnish the Office of the President, the Representative of the Legislative District concerned, Philippine Postal Corporation, National Historical Institute and other concerned offices with a copy of this Ordinance for their information and proper guidance pursuant to Section 13 (h) of the Local Government Code of 1991.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.





