ORDINANCE Numbered 50

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OWNERS OR OPERATORS OF CLUBS TO BUILD, KEEP AND MAINTAIN SECRET COMPARTMENTS WITHIN THE CLUB PREMISES.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner or operator of club to build, keep and maintain secret compartments within the club premises.

SEC. 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred pesos (P100.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (P200.00) or by imprisonment of not less than fifteen (15) days nor more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. If the violation is committed by a firm or corporation, the manager or managing director or person charged with the management of the premises of such firm or corporation shall be criminally responsible therefor.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
