ORDINANCE Numbered 61

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATES OF LICENSE FEES ON LUMBER YARDS IN QUEZON CITY, AS CLASSIFIED, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. "Lumber Yard," defined, classification. - For the purposes of this Ordinance the term "lumber yard" shall be construed to include every place where lumber, whether sawn or not, is kept or stored for sale or distribution. There shall be two classes of lumber yard; those which use machinery, whether propelled by steam or electricity and those which do not use any machinery.

SEC. 2. Licenses - No person shall have, keep, or store at his place of business, or elsewhere in Quezon City, any quantity of lumber for sale or distribution nor keep or maintain lumber yards without first having obtained a license therefor from the City Treasurer.

SEC. 3. License fees; approval of applications; - There shall be paid in advance to the City Treasurer for every license granted for having, keeping or storing lumber in any lumber yard the following annual fees:

Class A-Lumber yard without machinery:

"With a yard for the deposit of lumber  
having a space of more than 2,000 sq. m. -- P200.00

"With a yard for the deposit of lumber  
having a space of 2,000 sq. m. or less ---- 100.00

Class B-Lumber yard with machinery:

"From 1 to 25 horse powers ----- 175.00

"From 25 to 100 h.p. ----- 250.00

"From 101 to 200 h.p. ----- 300.00

"From 201 to 500 h.p. ----- 400.00

"Over 500 h.p. ----- 500.00

PROVIDED, That all applications for such licenses shall be referred to the Chief of Police and fire department of the City and their approval first had thereon.

SEC. 4. Penalties. - Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than fifty pesos (P50.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (P200.00) or by imprisonment of not less than twenty (20) days nor more than two (2) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court, for each offense.

SEC. 5. Repealing Clause. - All provisions of previous ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. This Ordinance shall take effect <sup>Created with</sup> its approval.
