ORDINANCE Numbered 79

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PRIVATE CONTRACTORS DOING CONSTRUCTION WORK IN QUEZON CITY TO REGISTER IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ENGINEER AND TO PAY A REGULATORY FEE OF TWENTY PESOS (P20.00) A YEAR BEFORE UNDERTAKING THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY PROJECT.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. To safeguard public interests and for the proper supervision and enforcement of existing laws and ordinances, private contractors doing construction work in Quezon City are hereby required to register in the Office of the City Engineer and to pay a regulatory fee of twenty pesos (P20.00) a year to the City Treasurer before commencing the construction of any project.

SEC. 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty pesos (P20.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (P200.00) or by imprisonment of not less than eight (8) days nor more than two (2) months or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. If the violation is committed by a firm or corporation, the manager or managing director or person charged with the management of the business of such firm or corporation shall be criminally responsible therefor.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
