ORDINANCE Numbered 83

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PISTOL AND RIFLE TARGET ASSOCIATIONS IN QUEZON CITY TO APPLY FOR A PERMIT FROM THE CITY MAYOR EVERY YEAR, AND PAY TO THE CITY TREASURER A PERMIT FEE OF TWENTY-FIVE PESOS (P25.00) A YEAR AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. Pistol and Rifle Target Associations in Quezon City are hereby required to apply for a permit from the City Mayor every year, which permit shall be granted after investigation and upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, and upon payment to the City Treasurer of a permit fee of twenty-five pesos (P25.00) a year.


SEC. 2. Violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five pesos (P25.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (P200.00), or by imprisonment of not less than ten (10) days nor more than two (2) months or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
