AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8 (A) AND (B) OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-2381, S-2015, PROVIDING BUDGET ALLOCATION FOR FREE PNUEMOCOCCAL VACCINATION TO ALL REGISTERED SENIOR CITIZENS OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the 19<sup>th</sup> City Council previously approved Ordinance No. SP-2381, S-2015, providing free pneumococcal vaccination to all registered resident senior citizens of Quezon City, which shall be administered by the Quezon City Health Department subject to availability of 23-valent Polysaccharide vaccine;

WHEREAS, Section 8 of the said Ordinance provides that:

"Section 8. Budget Allocation – Budget allocation for the program shall be as follows:

- a) Annual funds necessary for the Pneumococcal vaccination of Senior Citizens shall be included in the Next Annual Budget of Quezon City; or
- b) Funds necessary for the vaccination may be augmented from any existing funds available,"

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2494, S-2016 was likewise approved by the City Council, mandating the Quezon City Government to set aside at least one percent (1%) of its general fund and allocate the same for programs, projects, and activities of senior citizens;

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend Section 8 (a) and (b) of the said Ordinance so as to provide a definite budget allocation for the purchase and/or acquisition of 23-valent Polysaccharide vaccine to sufficiently supply the needs of the senior citizens who are not yet vaccinated.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED.

SECTION 1. Section 8 of Ordinance No. SP-2381, S-2015 shall be amended as follows:


"Section 8. Budget Allocation - An initial budget allocation in the amount of at least Twelve Million Pesos (Php12,000,000.00) will be allocated for the purchase and/or acquisition of 23-valent Polysaccharide vaccines equally appropriating Two Million Pesos (Php 2,000,000.00) for each of the six (6) districts of this city, subject to existing auditing rules and procedures. The said initial budget allocation may be increased or decreased in the succeeding years depending on the number of registered senior citizens who shall need vaccination, as may be periodically determined by the Health Department and the Quezon City Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs (QC-OSCA).

SECTION 2. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or illegal by any court of competent jurisdiction, those parts that are not so declared shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Any previous Ordinance/s or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed or superseded accordingly.






SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




