ORDINANCE Numbered 89

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE HUNTING OF GAMES WITHIN QUEZON CITY AND IMPOSING FINE FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. Hunting in any place within the residential districts of Quezon City is hereby prohibited.

SEC. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to use any hunting weapon, rifle, shotgun or pistol, whether licensed or not, for the purpose of hunting small or big games within Quezon City, without first securing the necessary permit from the Mayor and the Chief of Police and without paying to the City Treasurer a permit fee of two pesos (P2.00), which permit shall be good for ten (10) days.

SEC. 3. Violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten pesos (P10.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (P200.00) or by imprisonment of not less than four (4) days nor more than two (2) months or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
