ORDINANCE Numbered 93

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING LICENSE FEES ON ESTABLISHMENTS FOR MANUFACTURING, CHARGING, AND RECHARGING BATTERIES OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. License - No person or entity shall conduct or engage in the business of manufacturing, charging, and recharging batteries of motor vehicles without first having obtained a permit from the Mayor and the license from the City Treasurer.

SEC. 2. For every license granted as herein provided, there shall be charged the following yearly license fee as scheduled below:

Class B - For manufacturing, charging and recharging batteries of motor vehicles or both connected with the repair of motor vehicles - - 300.00

Class C - For charging and recharging batteries of motor vehicles without connection with the sale of motor vehicles - - - - - - - - 100.00

- SEC. 3. Application The owner or manager of an establishment shall, before operating the business, file an application with the Office of the City Mayor giving full statement of his establishment, sanitary conditions, the kind of machinery to be used with the number of horse power, and must comply first with all requirements of the City Engineer and City Health Officer.
- SEC. 4. Penalty Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five pesos (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (\$200.00) or by imprisonment for not less than ten (10) days nor more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval. Unanimously passed, June 16, 1947.
