ORDINANCE Numbered 96

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DIGGING OR EXCAVATION OF PUBLIC ROADS OR STREETS IN QUEZON CITY WITHOUT A WRITTEN PERMIT TO BE ISSUED BY THE CITY ENGINEER UPON PAYMENT OF A PERMIT FEE OF FIVE PESOS (P5.00) AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to dig or excavate any public roads or street without a written permit from the City Engineer and without paying a permit fee of five pesos (P5.00) to the City Treasurer, besides the fees and charges required in Ordinance No. 30, current series.

SEC. 2. Violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five pesos (P25.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (P200.00), or by imprisonment of not less than ten (10) days nor more than two (2) months or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
