OC enhances learning system in day care centers

THE Quezon City government will enhance the city's barangay day care center program to ensure that children aged four and below will be ready to enter the formal learning system.

Mayor Herbert Bautista signed into law City Ordinance 2638-2018 known as the Barangay Day Care Center Enhancement Program which aims to promote

and maintain equality of access to education.

The ordinance, which was introduced by Councilors Alexis Herrera, Raquel Malangen, Franz Pumaren and Godofredo Liban II, will also provide basic educational materials to the barangay day care students as the child's learning capacity, personal and special interaction will grow and develop when he/she reaches the age of five.

"While parents have the primary responsibility to provide for their children's physical, emotional, psychological, mental and social needs, barangay day care service aims to supplement the inability of some parents to provide their children with the proper care

and home environment," the ordinance said.
