ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2726**, S-2018

AN ORDINANCE CREATING "THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE BOARD" THAT SHALL BE TASKED TO FORMULATE A COMPREHENSIVE AND RATIONALIZED LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE PLAN AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, to address the growing transport problem within the city, the assistance of the Quezon City Local Government should be utilized to become a pro-active partner of the Department of Transportation (DOTr), Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) and private sectors in creating a long-term effective solution to traffic;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code mandated the following Departments namely:

- a. The City Planning and Development Office: (1) To formulate integrated economic, social, physical and other development plans and policies for consideration of the Local Development Council (2) conduct continuing studies, research and training programs necessary to evolve plans and programs for implementation (3) integrate and coordinates all plans and studies undertaken by the local government unit's various

functional groups or agencies (4) monitor and evaluate the implementation of the different development programs, projects and activities in the local government unit concerned in accordance with the approved development plan.

- b. The Engineering Department: (1) Deals with all engineering works and surveying of the city (2) performs such services relative to public improvements (3) take charge of road construction, road maintenance and (4) construction and maintenance of all public buildings.
- c. The Department of Public Order and Safety: (1) Provide public security (2) Augment auxiliary services on traffic management (3) Formulate plans and programs that improve public safety (4) Undertake protective and disaster relief services (5) Issue Temporary Terminal Permits for jeepneys and tricycles, traffic clearances for business establishments, security clearances for security agencies, and clearing of sidewalks of illegal vendors and obstructions.

WHEREAS, it is timely that the Quezon City Local Government through its different departments to create/determine a comprehensive and rationalized public transport plan because they are knowledgeable in the formulation of policies not only within their territory but also to its adjoining cities, monitor the volume of motor vehicles in main thoroughfares and gather information through public consultation for the benefit of the riding public.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Quezon City Public Transport Service Board."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY - It is the declared policy of the city to develop and maintain a high quality public transport system that is reliable, safe, convenient and compliant to environmental soundness.

SECTION 3. QUEZON CITY PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE BOARD - The Board shall be composed of a Chairman to be headed by the City Mayor and the following as members:

- a. Head of the City Planning and Development Office.
- b. Head of the Engineering Department.
- c. Head of the Department of Public Order and Safety.

- d. Chairman of the Committee on Transportation, Quezon City Council.
- e. Representative from Department of Transportation.
- f. Representative from Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board.
- g. At least two (2) representatives from Transport Sectors.
- h. At least two (2) representatives from Private Sectors.
- i. Liga President

SECTION 4. DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES -

- a. To conduct/prepare basic research, guidelines, plans and policies of Road Transport Services within the city and its adjoining cities;
- b. To coordinate/consult with other agencies such as the Department of Transportation (DOTr), Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) and private sectors;
- c. To initiate public consultations and surveys with different sectors, stakeholders and other concerned entities;
- d. To collect data and identify which routes were under-served or over-served;
- e. Other matters relative to the development of Public Transport Services.

SECTION 5. ANNUAL REPORT - The Board shall submit to the City Mayor and to the Quezon City Council its annual report for guidance and approval.

SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) - The City Planning and Development Office, the Engineering Department and the Department of Public Order and Safety shall draft the IRR for proper operation of this Ordinance within 180 days after its effectivity, with the Quezon City Council Committee on Transportation copy furnished.





SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.




