ORDINANCE Numbered 123

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF NINE HUNDRED PESOS (₱900.00) TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE DISMANTLING, TRANSFERRING AND CONVERTING THE QUONSET HUT IN SAN JUAN DEL MONTE DONATED BY MR. ERIBERTO AGUINALDO INTO A HOME ECONOMICS BUILDING FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, QUEZON CITY; SAID AMOUNT TO BE CHARGEABLE TO THE BALANCE OF THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE THREE-ROOM ADDITION TO SAID SCHOOL.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of nine hundred pesos (₱900.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, out of the ₱1,362.78 balance in the original appropriation of the three-room addition in San Francisco Elementary School Building, is hereby re-appropriated to be made available for the dismantling, transferring, and converting the quonset hut in San Juan del Monte, donated by Mr. Eriberto Aguinaldo, into a Home Economics Building for the San Francisco del Monte Elementary School, Quezon City.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
