

QC villages get Real Property Tax Share

THE Quezon City government under the administration of Mayor Herbert Bautista has turned over to the 142 *barangays* (villages) their real property tax share for the second quarter of 2018.

The distribution of real property tax share was organized by the Barangay Operations Center and Community Relations Department (BCRD) in coordination with the City Treasurer's Office (CTO).

Quezon City District 1 got a total of P7.3 million, District 2 got P9.2 million, District 3 with P17.8 million, District 4 got P27.5 million, while District 5 got P32.6 million, and P36.3 million went to District 6.

Among the *barangays* with the highest share are: Socorro, Bagumbayan, South Triangle, *Pinyahan*, *Tandang Sora*, *Matandang Balara*, *Kaligayahan*, Loyola Heights, *Batasan Hills*, and *Kaunlaran*.

The city government expects barangay officials to allocate their shares to livelihood, education, infrastructure, health and social services, among others.

To meet the government's expectations, Brgy. St. Ignatius Chairman Edwin Tansingco explained that the Real Property Tax Share is already a part of a *barangay's* annual budget and are allotted for its respective use.
