

QC ADOPTS COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR 2017- 2020

THE Quezon City Council has passed a resolution adopting the Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) of the QC government for 2017-2020. City Resolution SP 7473-2018 introduced by Councilor Roderick Paulate aims to adopt the CDP pursuant to the Local Government Code of 1991 that mandates the local government unit (LGU) to prepare a comprehensive multi-sectoral development plan to be initiated by its development council and approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The City Development Council (CDC) shall formulate annual, medium-term and long-term socio-economic development plans and policies. The CDP promotes the general welfare of its inhabitants through consolidated programs and projects necessary to carry out objectives of different sectors. Among the 43 priority projects under the CDP are formulation of a drainage master plan for QC, development of low-cost mass housing projects for low-income earners, upgrade of urban poor communities, construction of multi-purpose evacuation centers, expansion of the waste-to-energy, establishment of shelters/home for abandoned, neglected and abused elderly and persons with disability and construction of QC Convention Center.
