

Mayor Bautista donates ambulance to QCPD

QUEZON City Mayor Herbert Bautista has donated a Level 1 ambulance vehicle to the District Health Service of the QC Police District in a City Hall ceremony on July 9.



Part of the batch of 160 ambulance vehicles recently acquired by the city, the donation is aimed at making the city police an integral part of Quezon City's continuing drive to boost its disaster response and medical care capabilities.

The ambulance vehicle, as well as the 159 others, passed Level 1 standards and is equipped with Automated External Defibrillators (AED) Plus that can be used for negative pulse rate and cardiac arrest situations.

It is also equipped with oxygen

tanks, spinal boards, stretchers, first aid kits, and other medical equipment necessary for emergency use.

Mayor Bautista was represented by QC Fourth District Councilor Raquel Malangen during the turnover ceremony.

Mayor Bautista earlier said his administration's latest acquisition of state of the art emergency vehicles is part of continuing drive to make the Barangay Emergency Response Team of the Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council the best in the entire country.
