## ORDINANCE Numbered 143

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FOUR THOUSAND PESOS (\$4,000.00)
TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AND EXPENDED EXCLUSIVELY FOR PEACE AND
ORDER CAMPAIGN; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE USE OF SUCH FUND
TO CARRY THE PURPOSES OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the promotion and maintenance of peace and order has been the greatest concern of the administration;

WHEREAS, this Council, in its desire to cooperate with the administration, is employing all available ways and means within its power to help carry out successfully the all-out campaign against crimes and lawlessness; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that all law-enforcing agencies should pool their resources together and be amply provided with necessary funds in order to reduce to a negligible minimum these utter disregards of the law and threats to public peace and order;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City,

SECTION 1. The sum of four thousand pesos (\$\frac{7}{4},000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated, or if there is none at present, necessary reversions be effected, to be made available and expended exclusively for peace and order campaign.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make use of the fund appropriated in Section 1 hereof in the manner he may deem proper to affect the successful prosecution of the peace and order campaign contemplated in this Ordinance, including the appointment of personnel, inherent and necessary in the campaign, whose salaries shall be fixed by him and shall also be chargeable to this fund.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
