

QC gov't fetes outstanding barangay councils in protection for children



QUEZON City government commended the *Barangay* (village) Councils of Commonwealth, Culiat, and Greater Lagro for bagging numerous awards during the recent Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC) Congress *Gawad Kalayaan*.

The Quezon City Council handed over an enlarged framed

copy of City Resolution 7416-2018, introduced by Councilors Franz Pumaren, Godofredo Liban 2nd, Jose Mario Don De Leon, and Ricardo Corpuz, to the officials of Barangay Commonwealth, Culiat, and Greater Lagro during the flag-raising ceremony program at the Quezon City Hall.

has been named champion for "*Tatak Barangay*" best practices, first place outstanding child's rights advocate (individual children and youth category), and first place also in outstanding child's rights advocate (individual adult category).

On the other hand, Barangay Culiat received the Tatak Baran-

gay first runner-up, and Barangay Greater Lagro as the Tatak Barangay second runner-up.

The BCPC Congress is an annual event that recognizes the efforts of the barangay in Metro Manila, Cavite, Rizal, Pampanga, and in other cities in implementing the juvenile justice and welfare act in the community level.
