

Quezon City renews sister-cities ties with Davao City



TWO of the nation's premier cities—Quezon City and Davao City—have renewed their sister-cities ties in ceremonies hosted by Quezon City Mayor Herbert Bautista and Vice Mayor Joy Belmonte at the Carlos Albert Hall of Quezon City Hall on June 27, 2018.

The cooperation between the two cities aims to further promote the mutual developments of their environment, human resources and community development,

science and technology, education, sports, tourism, trade and disaster risk reduction, among others.

The Memorandum of Understanding of Sister City Cooperation between Quezon City and Davao City was first forged in 1994 by late mayor Ismael Mathay Jr. and then Davao City Mayor President Rodrigo Duterte.

The renewal of the MoU was signed by Vice Mayor Belmonte and her counterpart, Vice Mayor Bernard Al-ag.
