QC adds 131 classrooms

The Quezon City government has added 131 classrooms in the city's public schools in time for the opening of classes on Monday. With this, Mayor Herbert Bautista said the addition ensures a more manageable student to classroom ratio as the country is constantly besieged by the shortage of classrooms. In many parts of the country, the shortage of classrooms have been a perennial problem as some have conducted their classes in gymnasium, tents and other makeshift classrooms. Others public schools were forced to accommodate more than the desired 30 students in one classroom as the number have reached as much as 70 in some schools.
