

QC TO GIVE P1.2M AID TO INFORMAL SETTLERS AFFECTED BY ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

OVER 200 Informal Settler Families (ISFs) who will be affected by the road improvement projects in the villages of Sto. Domingo and Manresa will receive a financial aid worth P5,000 each. The Quezon City Council passed a resolution authorizing Mayor Herbert Bautista to extend financial assistance amounting to P1.2 million. The Resolution, introduced by Councilor Alexis Herrera, aims to provide affected ISFs a start upon moving to the National Housing Authority (NHA) Resettlement site in Morong, Rizal. The city has implemented road improvement projects along Sto. Domingo Street, Pagatan Street and Panaltural Street in Barangay Sto. Domingo and Barangay Manresa. The QC Housing Community Development and Resettlement Department has identified 244 verified ISFs occupying the right- of- ways of the streets.
