

QC emergency personnel undergo training

THE Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office has organized a three-day seminar-workshop on Hydrometeorological Hazards to its Emergency Operations Center personnel.

Weather specialists from the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (Pagasa) served as trainers in the seminar. Topics that were discussed include weather hazards, different types of weather, interpreting Pagasa's weather advisories, weather and flood forecasting and early warning system,

weather and climate monitoring.

Staff from the Quezon City Public Affairs and Information Services Office also participated in the seminar-workshop.

The training is organized to orient the QC DRRMO EOC personnel on the proper interpretation of Pagasa's weather and climate terminologies and the best way to disseminate information.
