## Mayor Bautista to provide P1.5M financial aid to public school teachers

Quezon City public school teachers will receive more medical, burial and other welfare assistance as the Quezon City Council passed a resolution authorizing Mayor Herbert Bautista to provide P1,500,000.00 financial assistance to the QC Public School Teachers Association (QCPSTA).

City Resolution 7594-2018, introduced by Councilor Raquel Malangen, aims to provide assistance to QCPSTA for their welfare benefit projects, such as the Death Aid Contribution System (DACS), free annual medical check-up, rice subsidy allowance, retired teachers medical assistance program, and medical assistance fund for the seriously ill members.

The QCPSTA is the official organization of teachers and non-teaching personnel under the Division of City Schools-QC with 16,500 members from 143 member-schools.

The Quezon City Public School Teachers Association is an affiliate of both the Alliance of Concerned Teachers (ACT) and the Philippine Public School Teachers Association.
