Quezon City Council launches 'Batas QC' mobile application

Law enforcers and barangay officials applauded the Quezon City Council, led by Vice Mayor Joy Belmonte, for creating "Batas QC," the first mobile application on local ordinances, that will help implement city ordinances more efficiently.

"Batas QC" presents the council's legislations where users may view announcements and schedules of the City Council.

Currently, "Batas QC" is available on the android platform and can be downloaded through Google Playstore.

During its launch on Nov. 6, over 300 mobile tables and devices were given to the Quezon City Police District Commanders and community precincts, Environmental Protection and Waste Management Department (EPWMD) environmental enforcers, Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) traffic enforcers, barangays, and Sangguniang Kabataan Federation.

PSupt. Wilson Delos Santos, chief of the Traffic Enforcement Unit of the Quezon City Police District, said that the app will become really useful as it will be utilized by the police as reference on the ordinances.

According to Barangay Libis Chairperson Leny Glivano, law enforcers in their barangay take so much time looking for specific ordinances to cite against violations.

Through Batas QC, the law enforcement process will be implemented more efficiently, Glivano said.
