

Quezon City increases teachers' rice allowance

QUEZON City Mayor Herbert Bautista approved an ordinance increasing the rice allowance of public school personnel from P1,500 to P2,000 in recognition of their valuable services to society.

Introduced by Councilor Julianne Alyson Rae Medalla, City Ordinance 2754-2018 amends its 2014 edition that grants a P1,500 quarterly rice allowance for teaching and non-teaching personnel of the Division of City Schools of Quezon City (QCDCS).

"This ordinance aims to increase the rice allowance to P2,000 as

assistance and in recognition of the contribution of our public school personnel as they nurture the future leaders of our country," the ordinance reads.

Starting in the first quarter of 2019, QC teachers and non-teaching staff under the QCDCS will receive P2,000 rice allowance quarterly.

Under the administration of Mayor Bautista, the city has been providing for the needs of the education sector, specifically for the benefit of teachers and non-teaching personnel.
