

Joy Belmonte tops QC mayoral survey

IF the elections were held today, Quezon City Vice Mayor Joy Belmonte would win over First District Rep. Vincent Crisologo for the top post in the city.

Belmonte, who garnered 59 percent, edged out Crisologo (17 percent) in #PahayagNCR, an independent poll conducted by research firm PUBLiCUS Asia Inc. on November 16-20 among 1,800 registered voters in Metro Manila.

"I'm very thankful to God and to our constituents for this positive response. We have a long way to go, but I am con-

fident that my call for better governance and inclusive development will be heard loud and clear," she said when reached for comment.

Belmonte, who is on her 3rd term as vice mayor, is running under a platform of good governance and improved social services for her bid in the National Capital Region's largest city.

Meanwhile, Crisologo ranked over Ismael "Chuck" Mathay 3rd, who only garnered 2 percent.
