ORDINANCE Numbered 1

AN ORDINANCE DIVIDING QUEZON CITY INTO FOUR DISTRICTS REPRESENTED BY MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMINISTRATION.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City:

Section 1. For the purpose of administration Quezon City is hereby divided into four districts to be represented by different members of the City Council, as follows.

Diliman District. To embrace Diliman Estate and the bounded by Calle España, Dario and Salapan Rivers and the boundary of the City of Manila and represented by Councilor Alejandro Roces, Sr.

San Francisco del Monte District. To embrace the Area morth of Calle España and west of Diliman Estate, including San Francisco del Monte and Sta. Mesa Estates, to be represented by Councilor Jose Paez.

Cubao (Ord 4)
Gandaluyong District. To embrace those portions the Magdalena and Mandaluyong Estates included in the City and represented by Vice-Tyor Vicente Fragante.

University Dist. 2t. To embrace those po ons of the Belare Filter sites & ? those portions of the ariquina and Fieda: Estates included in the City and represented by Councilor Busebio D. Aguilar.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its Bassage.
