

QC Council bags three-peat for Most Outstanding Sangguniang Panlungsod

FOR three consecutive terms, the Quezon City Council has been hailed as the Most Outstanding Sangguniang Panlungsod in Metro Manila for its "progressive performance on legislating measures responsive to the needs of the community" by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG).

Vice Mayor Joy Belmonte, head of the QC Sangguniang Panlungsod, was grateful for receiving the 2018 Local Legislative Award for the Highly Urbanized Category at the regional level.

"We would like to thank DILG for bestowing the Most Outstanding Sangguniang Panlungsod award to Quezon City Council in the National Capital Region," Belmonte said in her acceptance speech.
