

QC teachers to receive longevity pay hike

QUEZON City Mayor Herbert Bautista recently signed a city ordinance increasing the longevity pay of QC public school teachers by as much as 300 percent.

City Ordinance 2782-2018 orders that the teachers' longevity pay of P100 for every five years of continuous service will be increased to P400.

"Such amount as may be necessary for the implementation of this ordinance is hereby appropriated from the General

Fund or Special Fund," the ordinance states.

Teachers who have rendered at least five years of continuous service, exclusive of such services outside Quezon City, will benefit from the pay hike.

Mentors who have rendered at least at least 10 years of service but registered a year's worth of leave are still eligible for the new benefit as long as their leave arose on account of medical and/or grave personal circumstances.
