ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2751, S-2018

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A MONTHLY SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOWANCE OF ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP1,500.00) TO NATIONAL PAID PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHING AND NON TEACHING PERSONNEL IN QUEZON CITY, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution recognizes the importance of education in the achievement of national growth as it assigns the highest budgetary priority and ensure that teaching will attract and retain its rightful share of the best available talents through adequate remuneration and other means of job satisfaction and fulfillment;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorizes local government units to provide adequate support to efficient and effective provision of basic services such as education;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Local Government of Quezon City to promote and improve the social and economic status of its public school teaching and non-teaching personnel;

WHEREAS, this Ordinance aims to assist our public school personnel and recognize their immense contribution to society as they nurture the future leaders of our country.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. PROVISION OF MONTHLY SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOWANCE – National Paid Public school teaching and non-teaching personnel shall hereby be provided with a monthly supplemental allowance of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,500.00).

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION – Such amount as may be necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE – All ordinances, executive orders and administrative regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other parts or provision thereof which are not affected shall continue to remain in full force and effect.





SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




