ORDINANCE Numbered 56

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF \$106.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF THE CITY, FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO PISTOLS WITH HOLSTERS FOR THE USE OF THE MOTORCYCLE COPS THAT WILL BE APPOINTED TO THE TWO OF THE FOUR NEWLY CREATED POSITIONS AUTHORIZED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 55, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE GENERAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1940-1941.

WHEREAS, under Item No. I-7, page 8, of Ordinance No. 55, the City Council authorized the creation of the positions of four motorcycle cops;

WHEREAS, under Item No. II-23, page 9, of same Ordinance, the City Council has authorized the purchase of only one pistol with holster;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police, in his letter of July 12, 1940, explained the importance and necessity of purchasing two more additional pistols with holsters for the use of the motorcycle cops that will be appointed to the positions so authorized;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$106.00 is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated funds of the City for the purchase of two additional pistols with holsters.

SECTION 2. The amount appropriated in this ordinance shall be expended solely for the purpose herein authorized and for no other.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
