

Belmonte vows to get rid of corruption

QUEZON City Vice Mayor Josefina “Joy” Belmonte on Tuesday vowed to get rid of corruption if she wins the mayoral contest in May.

“I survived nine years of being a vice mayor without taking a single cent of the people’s money. And I will prove the cynics wrong. Quezon City is ready to be cleaned up,” she said.

“I did not do anything wrong. You can easily check my track record. I am proud to say that my track record is impeccable,” Belmonte stressed. In October last year, Belmonte pledged to stamp out corruption in Quezon City in accordance with the “Bantay Korapsyon” advocacy campaign of the Department of the Interior and Local Government. Belmonte also committed to promote information transparency, accountability and civil society engagements as the city was tapped for the pilot program of the anti-corruption drive.
