ORDINANCE Numbered 70 ✓

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ADVERTISEMENT OF SHOWS, CIRCUSES AND OTHER SIMILAR ENTERTAINMENTS BY SCATTERING, DISTRIBUTING OR CIRCULATING PROGRAMS OR LEAFLETS ALONG THE STREETS OR OTHER PLACES IN QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, manager, owner or person in charge of any show, movie-house, circus or any other similar entertainment to scatter, distribute or circulate or allow or cause to be scattered, distributed or circulated along the streets or public places in Quezon City, programs or leaflets advertising any kind of attraction or entertainment.

Section 2. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than P200.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
