'Belmonte brand' of leadership: Accountability, zero corruption in QC

LESS than a week before the elections, Quezon City mayoralty candidate Vice Mayor Joy Belmonte renewed her pledge of maintaining the "Belmonte Brand" by upholding fairness, honesty, transparency, accountability and zero corruption in her term if she will take over the top post in the city.

Belmonte also thanked her supporters following the latest survey by RP-Mission and Development Foundation Inc. (RPMDinc) that she topped with 60 percent voter preference. This showed a 28 percent lead in voter preference over opponents Cong. Vincent Crisologo, with 32 percent, and Ismael Mathay 3rd with 4 percent.

She also mentioned the 95 percent trust rating she obtained in the previous survey by RPMDinc. dated April 19 to 25 where the study inferred that her 62 percent of votes are "solid votes" and would not change given her high trust rating.
