

CJ Bersamin thanks QC for new Justice Hall

SUPREME Court Chief Justice Lucas Bersamin expressed appreciation for Quezon City government's support to the judiciary during the inauguration of the new Justice Hall in Quezon City on May 2.

The chief magistrate and Quezon City Mayor Herbert Bautista led the inauguration of the new structure located at the Quezon City Hall compound.

The new Justice Hall will house more courts and offices for the QC Regional Trial Court.

Justice Bersamin, himself a former judge of the QC-RTC, expressed gratitude to the local government for its continuous support to the judiciary's administration of justice.

The QC government under the

administration of Mayor Bautista helped fund the construction of the new Justice Hall, donated brand-new buses called Justice on Wheels that serve as travelling courthouses,

and provided for additional manpower to the local courts.

The city also built a new structure housing prosecutors' offices.

"We are truly grateful that we will

have another building to accommodate all the RTC courts, numbering 49 courts as of now," Quezon City Executive Judge Cecilyn Burgos-Villavert for her part said.
