Quezon City opens new senior high school in Pinyahan

QUEZON CITY Mayor Herbert Bautista, together with Education Secretary Dr. Leonor Briones, led the inauguration of a new four-story senior high school in Flora Ylagan, Barangay Pinayahan on Tuesday, 21 May 2019.



The new Flora Ylagan Senior High School building houses 23 classrooms and laboratories for incoming senior high school students.

During Bautista's term as the chief executive, the classroom shortage has been reduced to less than 1000 from 3,000.

From 2010 to present, Quezon City has invested over 3 billion pesos for the construction of additional school buildings, and 743 million pesos for the renovation and maintenance of existing structures.

Secretary Briones expressed her gratitude for the city's generosity in prioritizing education in its programs.

Quezon City under Mayor Bautista has invested very heavily for education. Although this is a national mandate, Quezon City really supported us, not only in academic programs but also in sports and technical- vocational (programs)," Sec. Briones said.
